include representatives from:

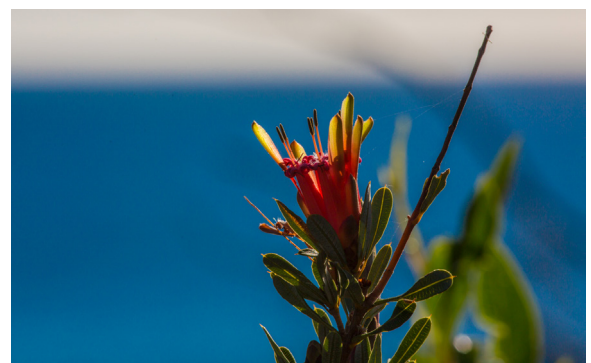
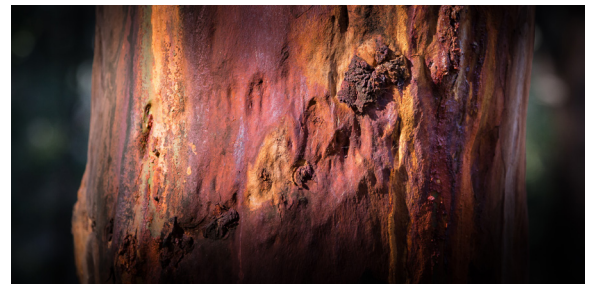
