Swamp expert **Ian Baird** will present an exciting insight into the biology and identification of two iconic threatened species found in Blue Mountains Swamps: **the Giant Dragonfly and the Blue Mountains Water Skink.**

BMCC's Environmental Scientist **Michael Hensen** will also talk about the new 10 year Environmental Trust Save our Species \$750,000 "Swamped by Threats" grant to protect the Blue Mountains Water Skink and the Giant Dragonfly at priority sites across the Blue Mountains and Newnes Plateau.
