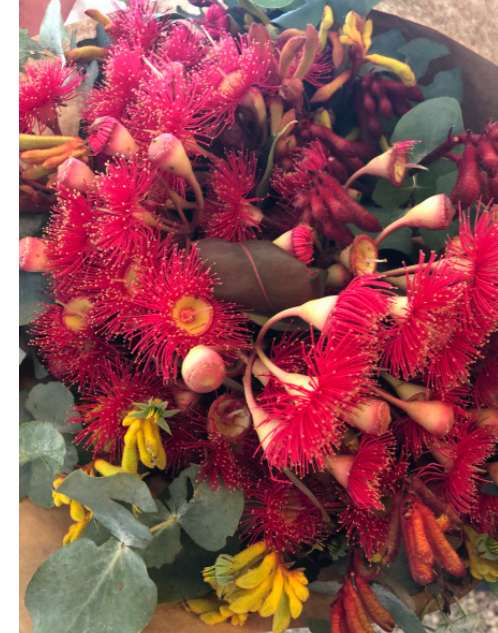
- **3pm - 5:30pm** Setting up of monitoring equipment for fauna monitoring
